Activity One: List 10 things that you use water for at your house. Choose two easy ways that you can conserve water at home. Write your ideas down below, and try to incorporate them into your day today.

Activity Two: The amount of fresh surface water on earth is very limited. To further investigate this let's look at the Great Lakes and how much water they alone contribute to the amount of fresh water on earth. What percentage of the world's fresh water is held in the Great Lakes? What percentage of North America's water is held in the Great Lakes?

Activity Three: Much of the earth's fresh surface water is held in glaciers and ice fields. With the earth's temperature rising what could be some impacts for humans and wildlife if or when that polar ice melts and ocean levels rise?

Activity Four: Create a watershed picture of a local watershed. Be sure to include creeks, rivers, and lakes names within that watershed. Within your picture add in places where water is used by humans like recreation, agriculture, or industry.

Keywords/terms to include in the final assignment: Water footprint, polar ice, polar bears, walrus, rising sea levels, watershed, watershed divide, conservation.
